

STUDENT CONDUCT ON SCHOOL BUSES

While the law requires the school district to furnish transportation, it does not relieve parents of students from being accountable for their conduct boarding the bus in the morning, traveling on the bus, and leaving the bus at the end of the school day.

the school year or a portion thereof. A student's riding privilege will not be suspended until parents are notified of the problem. When a student has been suspended from riding a school bus, it is the responsibility of the parent to see that the student gets to and from school safely.
